#### Student Records

All students must have on file an immunization form and health form filled in and signed by a doctor. The emergency form must be filled out (both sides) for all students. It is important that every line is filled in with the information requested pertaining to your child. <u>PLEASE MAIL by August 20 or PUT</u> IN THE SCHOOL DROP BOX ON AUGUST 26, 27 & 28 - from 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. : <u>EMERGENCY FORM, HEALTH FORM, IMMUNIZATION FORM, PRE-ADMISSION</u> <u>CONFERENCE FORM, GENERAL PERMISSION FORM, ALLERGY PLAN (for students with</u> allergies) & FINANCIAL FORM. These forms can be printed off of our website. Please include with the forms a photo of your child and a family photo for your student's file. Thank you!

<u>Tuition & Fees –  $1^{st}$  month tuition and one-time supply fee should be paid by August  $28^{th}$ .</u>

- \$55 one-time supply fee/snack fee
- Pre- K 4 year olds T -TH A.M. class \$185.00 per month
- \$55 one- time supply fee/snack fee
- Pre-K 4 year olds MWF A.M. class \$240.00 per month
- \$55 one-time supply fee/snack fee
- Pre-K 5 year olds MWF A.M. class- \$240.00 per month
- \$55 one-time supply fee/snack fee

\* <u>The fee is a one-time fee paid at the start of the school year to help cover the cost of scholastic readers, supplies and snacks.</u> All snacks will be provided by the school. Students will<u>not</u> be bringing snacks for their birthday.

\*\*Please note 5% tuition discount for 2<sup>nd &</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> child enrolled from the same family and 10% tuition discount for members of Minnesota Valley Church. Only one discount can apply per family.

CDCA's operating expenses are dependent on the commitment of parents to pay tuition <u>the first school</u> <u>day of each month</u>. Any changes to this plan, please contact Debbie Karban at 952-431-2025. The registration fee paid upon enrolling is not applied toward the monthly tuition. Checks should be made payable to CDCA. If paying cash – exact amount of cash must be in a labeled, sealed envelope with the date, amount & student's name. <u>Checks or cash should be placed in the drop box in the school arrival area or mailed to Christian Day Child Academy, 16075 Hawthorn Path, Lakeville, MN 55044.</u> No monthly bills are mailed out but late payment notices will be sent.
